Dear Mr. Sanmillan:

We are a coalition of organizations dedicated to promoting the right of free expression. We write in support of the right of students in Stuart Public Schools to participate in non-disruptive protest during school functions.

We recently learned that on October 5, the Stuart Public School Board of Education adopted a policy that requires students to stand for the national anthem or face disciplinary action. While the policy vaguely frames its constraints as 'expectations,' it directly undermines the spirit of the First Amendment by threatening students who do not comply with disciplinary action. Such threats impermissibly chill student speech.

Stuart Public School students have a constitutionally protected right to peaceful and non-disruptive political speech, which includes the right to protest. West Virginia v. Barnette, 319 U.S. 624 (1943). They are free to stand, sit, kneel, link arms, or gesture however they choose during the national anthem, provided that their actions are not materially and substantially disruptive. As arms of the government, bound by the First Amendment, Stuart school officials may not punish students for exercising this inalienable freedom.

We urge you to revoke your October 5th policy and clearly affirm the right of every Stuart Public School student to protest.

Please read our attached statement criticizing recent attempts to suppress student protests. We also invite you to consult our online resource on student protests. Thank you.
